

## Junior Lawn Bowling OLBC      Level 2 - Yellow

### 1. Terminology    You must know the following terms:

Draw shot	a slow shot where the bowl is rolled to a specific target (the jack)
Forehand draw	for a right handed player, a bowl is aimed to the right of the jack, curving from right to left
Backhand draw	for a right handed player, a bowl is aimed to the left of the jack, curving from left to right
Drive	a harder, faster bowl used to knock the jack or another bowl out of play. It is delivered so that it does not curve but goes straight
Swing	when the bowling arm is swung backward in a pendulum motion to ensure a smooth delivery of the bowl
Hog line	a distance 21 metres from the mat where the jack must pass to be in play

### 2. Delivery    Demonstrate that you are able to deliver a bowl with proper form (see Level 1)

### 3. Skill

- i) Deliver 3 out of 4 bowls using both forehand and backhand, to the screen placed 21 metres from the mat
- ii). Deliver the jack 3 out of 4 times, past the hog line and within the boundaries of the rink

### 4. Etiquette

Must know and demonstrate the rules of etiquette from Level 1.
