GREENS

I feel that the greens speed has improved greatly from last year, a little bit faster and little less green.

To have a green that plays well and us not having to muscle the bowls down to the end, we all must be aware of what needs to be done to take care of the surface. So, let's remember that, :-

When going on any given morning to practice not to use the shade part as it is still wet/damp from the overnight dew, and walking/bowling on that surface tramps down the grass sometimes resulting in wear and fungus growing and eventually killing the grass.

Dropping or plopping your bowls on the grass makes a divot or peels away the grass.

Greens sheets are needed when the grass is damp or wet so that any misshapen bowl doesn't leave a mark on the green.
